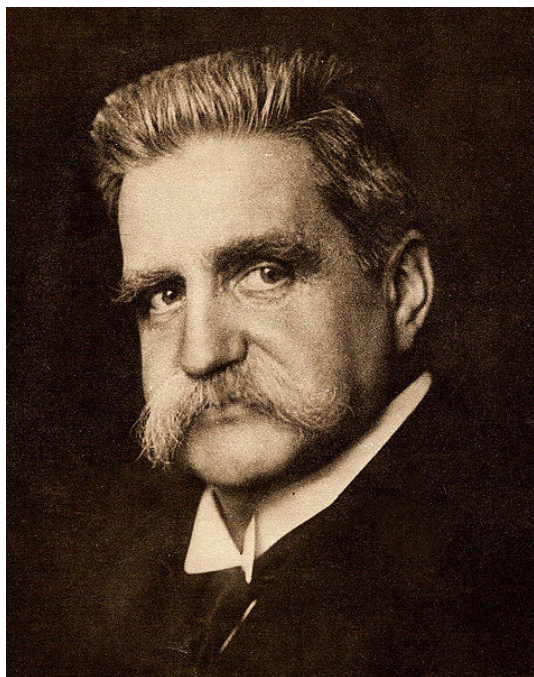


A Swedish Nobel Prize



Karl Hjalmar Branting

He was born on November 23rd, 1860 in Stockholm and he died on February 24th, 1925. He was a Swedish politician. He was the leader of the Swedish Social Democratic Party and (1907–1925) and Prime Minister during three separate periods (1920, 1921–1923, and 1924–1925). He was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1921 for his work in the League of Nations, sharing the prize with the Norwegian Christian Lous Lange.



His life

He studied astronomy and he was an assistant at Stockholm Observatory. However he gave up his career as a scientist to become a journalist in 1884. He is commemorated by the Branting Monument in Stockholm ⇒
